

Arizona Athletics Extra Yard for Teachers Contest Official Rules

No purchase necessary. The Contest begins at 12:01am Mountain Time on August 31, 2020 (the "Contest Start Date") and closes at 3:00 pm Mountain Standard Time on September 10, 2020 (the "Contest End Date") (such period being the "Contest Period"). Participation in the Contest constitutes full and unconditional agreement and acceptance of these Contest Rules, which are final on all matters relating to the Contest.

(1) How to Enter:

The University of Arizona department of intercollegiate athletics will host an online form on ArizonaWildcats.com. Those wishing to enter the Contest may nominate themselves or another person by completing the form and submitting by the Contest End Date. Information captured in the form includes: nominating teacher's name, email, school/ grade nominee teaches, and how long nominee has been teaching. Nominated teacher must include what Arizona Athletics sports program they play for and what years. Additional information will be needed if person submitting nomination is not the nominee. Contact information such as name, email, phone number and relationship to nominee must be included.

Submissions to the online form described above shall be referred to collectively herein as "Entries."

(2) Deadlines: Entries must be received before 3:01 pm Mountain Standard time on September 10, 2020.

(3) Who Can Play: Contest is open to University of Arizona department of intercollegiate athletics letterwinners also known as former student-athletes, who are also full-time teachers. Must currently teach in elementary school, middle school, or high school. Employees and immediate families (spouse, parents, siblings, and children) of the University of Arizona department of intercollegiate athletics and any recruitable or current student-athlete as determined by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) are not eligible to participate.

(4) Contest Prizes: On September 11, 2020 two winners will be selected. The University of Arizona department of intercollegiate athletics will randomly choose two names. In the event the winners cannot be contacted by 11:59pm the day of the selection, if it is discovered that they are not a former UA student-athlete/letterwinner, or declines the prize, alternate winners will be selected. No fee is necessary to participate. Participation is void where prohibited by law.

A cash prize of \$1,900.00 will be awarded to each winner. There will be two total winners.

(5) The winning prizes are non-transferable to any other person, including relatives or friends.

(6) Winners are solely responsible for all applicable federal, state and local taxes unless otherwise indicated.

(7) Chances of winning are dependent on number of Entries received prior to each selection date.

(8) A list of the winners (containing first name, last initial, and residence city) can be obtained after September 11, 2020, by writing to: "Arizona Athletics Extra Yard for Teachers Winners List," McKale Memorial Center, 1 National Championship Drive, P.O. (9) By entering, entrant agrees to follow the Official Rules and hold harmless and indemnify the Arizona Board of Regents, the University of Arizona, and each of their respective officers, employees and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") against any and all liability, damages or causes of action (however named or described), with respect to or arising out of either (i) the Contest, including entrant's participation and the University of Arizona's administration of the Contest; or (ii) the receipt or use of the prizes awarded in the Contest.

(10) Contest void where prohibited.

By entering the Contest, and whether or not entrant wins a prize in the Contest, each entrant grants to the Released Parties the right to the use of his or her name, likeness or photograph without compensation or further authorization in any publicity or for promotional purposes carried out by the Released Parties. No telephone contact or correspondence will be entered into except with potential prize winners. All travel and hotel accommodations shall be determined by the University of Arizona in its sole discretion.

The University of Arizona reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value and/or to terminate, modify or withdraw this Contest, in whole or in part (including altering the manner in which the prizes are distributed), at any time, without prior notice for any reason including, but not limited to, viruses, bugs, tampering or other causes beyond

the University of Arizona's control affect the administration, security, fairness or proper play or conduct of the Contest. Further, the University of Arizona reserves the right to disqualify any person and void any Entry of that person who it believes has tampered with the entry process or any other component of the Contest, whose conduct or action affects the administration, security or fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Contest, or who fails to meet or abide by the Contest Rules and conditions.

The University of Arizona does not assume any responsibility for tampering, theft, defects, viruses, human errors including negligence, deletions, technical or telephone, computer line, network, server, access providers, computer equipment or software problems, undeliverable messages, computer errors, lost, misdirected, late or incomplete Entries or inaccurate capture of information or any online difficulties that may result in damage or malfunction the computer or the failure of the University of Arizona to process any entry and otherwise award any prize.
